Our thoughts and prayers go out to Sharie Kenny and her family. Her husband Jack died Wednesday night after returning to the hospital less than 24 hours from when he was released on Saturday. Daughter Allyson shared that the family members were able to speak with him through a Zoom call Wednesday morning which was set up by the attending doctors and hospital staff. Jack chose not to be intubated due to serious lung damage and "chose the gentle hospice medications and comfort". Besides many years of square dancing and round dancing (cueing, choreographing and teaching ), Jack and Sharie chose to travel to many National Parks.
