This takes you to the Activity Search page. Enter the course number (41632) or name (Modern Square Dance) in the search box. This

will bring up a link to the registration page for the class, and students can follow the directions from there to register and to establish a Plano Parks and Rec. account if they don't already have one. Our club really needs these lessons to be successful to offset some of the loss of members that occurred during the COVID shutdown. 
