*** * * EVENTS FROM THE PAST WEEK * * ***

Plus 4s, Wednesday, September 3rd

22 Swinging Stars visited Plus 4s in Farmers Branch on Wednesday. The evening's all-plus tips were called by veteran club caller Charles Quizenberry, aka "Quiz." Couples were assigned to 1 of 4 squares each tip by Quiz's new computerized assignment program. Dancers enjoyed a lively evening of fun and sometimes challenging choreography. Lighter challenges included "spin chain thru" from many starting configurations while heavier challenges included sex-swapped variations of "spin chain the gears." Most squares struggled with the latter at first but Quiz, in his inimitable style, patiently doled out square-specific help mixed with friendly "jesting barbs" until all dancers were finally getting comfortable with these initially puzzling variations of the call. Through it all, all dancers survived, usually smiling, and most left a bit better dancers than they came. Visiting Swinging Stars included Amys, Bergesens, Bondis, Bursons, Esteps, Halvorsons, Kilejians, Lewises, Lloyds, Shermans, and Sherrells. Thanks to Jim Bondi for this report.

ADD+, Thursday, September 4th

7 Swinging Stars visited ADD+ in Richardson on Thursday for a couple hours of challenging all plus, all positions dancing. This particular dance was postponed from the preceding Labor Day Monday and featured guest caller Jerry Jestin. From Jerry, dancers expected "creative choreography" ... and they got plenty. One of the most interesting calls occurred right after Jerry carefully and stealthfully worked dancers, using just ordinary common calls, into the configuration you encounter after having completed the 1st two parts of Relay the Deucey (6 person wave plus 2 lone dancers, one off from each side of the wave roughly at the wave's midpoint). Then, he surprised dancers with "now do the last 4 parts of Relay the Deucey." As you might expect, this produced many pairs of glazed eyes, especially the first time. Though simpler, another call that all squares struggled with was Left Track Two. Despite some rough spots like these, most dancers handled the majority of Jerry's calls well throughout the evening and all dancers learned a few new things.
