Our First Vice President nominee is still vacant. I have one candidate willing provided someone will volunteer to chair the lessons committee. The Lessons Committee Chair would help with Advertising and scheduling the angels and lead angels. The chairperson would not have to be at lessons. Our angel attendees are fairly static with the same people coming to help and for the exercise.

Sunday, 11/3/2024, was a NORTEX meeting. In attendance was Dave & Lorraine Burson and yours truly. Most of the meeting was a review and approval of Rules and Regulations for NORTEX Beginner Square Dance Lessons Grant's. The discussion highlighted the Changes from the prior NORTEX Lessons Grant Guidelines. The first point being that these are now Rules and Regulations rather than Guidelines. Much of the discussion focused on the definition of a Beginner Student. The document defines it as per the following:

A beginner student dancer is defined as a person who has paid for the class or participated in free lessons and has NOT graduated from another NORTEX Club, has NOT joined a Club and has NOT joined NORTEX. A beginner student dancer has never taken square dance lessons or has been out of square dancing for ten plus (10+) years. Once a beginner student dancer has graduated from lessons, they are a New Dancer and no longer a beginner student dancer. (underline added)

The point was made that as soon as a student joins a club, NORTEX dues are due. The Grant will not be granted without a copy of the check paying the new members NORTEX dues. A deadline for filing the lessons grant application was added per the following:

The fall and spring application submission deadlines are January 15 and July 15, respectively. For the January submission date, graduation dates must fall between July 1 and December 31. For the July submission date, graduation must fall between January 1 and June 30.

Applications can be submitted prior to the submission deadline dates if the graduation date is within the submission range. Applications submitted outside of graduation range and submission date will not be accepted.
